**voting (corp)membership** **NOTE:** Persons running for or holding **any elected office** are ineligible for voting membership in WCMA during the time of running for or holding elected office.

**Full Membership:** full time administrative head of local government  
Dues 0.15% of salary with a minimum of \$75 \$

**Assistant Membership:** full time administrative assistant, assistant administrator, management analyst, or assistant to **Dues \$75**

**Retired Membership:** former Full Member now retired from active professional life  
**Dues \$40**

**Life Membership:** no fee. See WCMA bylaws for eligibility requirements. <https://wcma-wi.org/83/Bylaws>

**non-voting membership** *Non-voting members agree to adhere to Tenet 1 & 3 of the ICMA Code of Ethics*

**Affiliate Membership** *person who has an interest in professional local government management but is ineligible to apply for membership as a Voting Member. Not employed by private sector* **Dues \$75**

**Academic Membership** *university or college professors or academics* **Dues \$25**

**Consulting Membership** *those interested in cooperating with practicing administrators in the advancement of professional knowledge, such as individuals employed by private companies* **Dues \$350**

**Student Membership** - *person enrolled in an academic program at any college or university that has an interest in local government can not be a former WCMA Voting member* **Dues \$20.00**

In accordance with Tenet 7 of the ICMA Code of Ethics, any person running for or holding any elected office, regardless of federal, state, or local, is ineligible for membership in WCMA as a voting member.
